This bespoke family home in the Vale of Glamorgan replaces a long-abandoned Georgian dwelling, carefully reimagining the site while respecting its rural character. The design draws inspiration from the local vernacular and agricultural heritage utilising locally sourced stone and a landscape design that references the traditional field boundaries.

The exterior adopts a bold, angular form designed to read as an agricultural barn when viewed from a distance with its contemporary nature revealing itself as one draws near.

Elegant metal roofing and charred timber cladding offer a modern interpretation of traditional materials, grounding the building within its context while clearly expressing its contemporary intention.

In dramatic contrast to the exterior, the interior spaces are light and open. Flowing living areas provide the ideal backdrop for the owners’ collection of art and sculpture. Despite its gallery-like quality, the home remains warm and welcoming. It has been carefully designed to support everyday family life, with generous open spaces and practical, comfortable areas for living.
